PAIMI Program Statement of Priorities and Objectives - Appendix F

Priority/Goal Description: Promote the right of individuals with serious mental illness to live and receive supports and services in the most inclusive, integrated community settings appropriate for them. (community Integration)

Objective: Assist adults and children to remain in, or transition to the least restrictive residential settings and secure diversion alternatives to institutional placements.
